Engage all the stakeholders and utilise the infrastructure to develop technically sound and employable human resources to translate our vision in to a reality.



Decentralization and Committees to support the institution governance


Statutory committees like Governing Body, College Academic Committee(CAC) consisting of all the heads of the departments and Non-statutory committees like Anti Ragging committee, Women grievance Cell, Disciplinary committee etc. are constituted to involve the faculty in decision making and implementation. Decisions concerns with academic matters are decentralized.
